Information for members

About PVAI Governing Council Members election (4 Posts)

The election will be held on 24th August 2025 at Hotel Enrise by Sayaji, Nashik.

At polling place

Election Officials will give you instructions when you arrive at the polling place. They can also answer any questions you have about the voting.

To receive your ballot paper, an issuing officer will ask you following questions:

- What is your name?
- What is your life membership Number?
- If you're voting as a proxy, then your name & xerox copy of proxy form.

If your answer is not satisfactory or matching with our information, you will not be given a ballot paper

How to vote

The FOUR candidates who receives the most votes will be elected.

Decide which candidate you think is best for the position being elected and mark the box next to the name of that candidate. You can only vote for FOUR candidates, so only mark FOUR boxes.

If you make a mistake, ask an Election Official for another ballot paper and start again.

Once you have marked your ballot paper, fold it in half and place it in the ballot box.

Remember your vote is secret. You don't have to show or tell anyone who you have voted for.

No open campaign for any candidate is allowed at venue and if found such members /proxy will not allowed to vote and will have to leave the venue.

PVAI Rules and Regulations - Rule 14. VOTING RIGHTS

All promoter members, life members and ordinary members shall have equal voting rights. A member entitled to attend and vote at a general meeting of the Association is authorised to appoint a proxy to attend and vote at the meeting on his behalf. However, the proxy would not be entitled to speak at the meeting. For a proxy to be valid, the proxy form duly filled-in and signed will have to be deposited by the member in the registered office of the Association at least forty-eight hours before the time fixed for the meeting. The proxy appointed by the member need not be a member of the Association.
